FUNDING AGREEMENT

Caroline Bay School Library

Caroline Bay, Malekula Island, Vanuatu

Project Outline

Caroline Bay is a small village in a remote part of Vanuatu, accessible by boat only. The village school has 75 children from the local and surrounding villages. They learn in the national language, Bislama, as well as in French.

In 2014 construction was commenced on a library, but stopped due to a lack of funding. The vision was to construct a 72m2 library to house the many books already in storage in the village and in the school. Many French text books have been donated from New Caledonia as well. The vision also includes a Principal's Office and an open sided second floor which can be used for the viewing of school activities and sporting events as well as a stage for performances. So far, the foundations and most of the walls have been completed.

Sunny Malai, the school principal, is seeking funding to complete the project. Sam Statham, an Australian who visited the school in September 2024, will assist in seeking funding in Australia, to complete the project.
